Spring Greetings to Our Sandplay Friends & Colleagues



In the Northern Hemisphere, the Spring Equinox takes place between March 19th - 21st, when the periods of day and night are approximately equal. In the Southern Hemisphere, this is the period of the Autumnal Equinox.

We know from our Sandplay work, that conditions of balance between the light and the dark, the masculine and the feminine, precipitate a period of change. The psyche cannot tolerate this standstill of perfect balance. The psyche is dynamic and must be moving. It is the pressure of this standstill that forces the psychic energy down into the unconscious to be directed by the Self to new possibilities.



New beginnings, or transformation, as we call it in Sandplay, implicitly imply death and rebirth. It is a period of deep sorrow, surrender and loss, so profound as to obviate any possibility of hope. The miracle of the season is that undergoing this darkness eventually gives birth to a new light that brings hope and new possibilities. Thus, we have symbols of eggs, for potential; rabbits for their fecundity; and flowers for the glory of resurrection.

For Christians, this is celebrated as Easter. For other traditions around the world it is known as Alban Eilir, Eostar, Eostre, Feast of Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Festival of Trees, Lady Day, NawRuz, No Ruz, Ostara, Ostra, Rites of Spring, and The Vernal Equinox.


